Annual Scholarships

Who May Apply?

Adult students at Georgian Court University who have achieved the following criteria (Student **does not** have to be a member of the GCU Kappa Zeta Chapter of Alpha Sigma Lambda chapter to apply):

- Completed 24 semester hours of graded coursework at Georgian Court University. (Not including transfer credits, assessment hours, CLEP credit and the like and not including any courses in which the student is currently enrolled.)
- Achieved a grade point average of 3.2 on a 4.0 scale on all work taken at this institution
- Is enrolled in a baccalaureate degree program at this institution
- Has a financial need for assistance to complete the degree.

Applicant Evaluation Criteria

- Scholarship
- Leadership
- Personal statement
- Faculty recommendation
- Financial need

Georgian Court University can submit 2 applications for this national scholarship program. Kathie Gallant, the Chapter Councilor and Student Success Specialist at GCU must receive your completed application packet WITHOUT the GCU transcript by May 15, 2020 to be considered for submission. Once selected, the 2 GCU finalists will need to submit their official GCU transcripts to Kathie Gallant to be submitted to the national office for scholarship review.
