Georgian Court University will accept up to 75 credits from Brookdale Community College or other community colleges. Up to 15 additional credits will be accepted from 4-year institutions. At least 30 credits must be earned at Georgian Court University, including at least 15 credits in the Interdisciplinary Studies major.

Georgian Court University prefers that students complete the general education program as outlined above. However, please note the following: Effective Fall 2016, Brookdale Community College students who have earned an associate degree with a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 and have completed the general education requirements established in the statewide agreement are able to transfer those general education credits in full to satisfy a minimum of 45 (A.A.), 30 (A.S.), or 20 (other associate degree) credits of the Georgian Court University General Education Requirements. Only courses in which a grade of "C" or higher has been achieved are eligible for transfer. Courses transferred have Georgian Court University general education equivalents will be transferred as those equivalent courses. Other general education courses required by Brookdale Community College will be transferred as general education electives. If an equivalency is not transferred, all four of the following general education requirements must be fulfilled: a designated Religious Studies course, a designated Women and Gender Studies course, a designated Ethics course, and the Capstone course (GEN400).

Effective Fall 2011, students who have not earned a total of 42 credits in the general education area after completing the three courses listed above must earn the remaining general education credits by choosing courses that satisfy general education categories for which the students did not transfer equivalent courses.
